ALL COMPETITORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE A SIGNED PARENTAL CONSENT FORM ON THEM AT ALL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE DAY AS WELL AS THEIR ONLINE MEMBERSHIP CARD!

GENERAL RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY

JUNIOR competitors must be 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2025.

INTERMEDIATE competitors must be 21 years of age or under on 1st September 2025.

SENIOR competitors must be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2025.

OPEN Competitions can be entered by any member unless age restrictions stated.

Competitors can compete up an age group, unless age restrictions (i.e., over 18) or conditions (i.e., ATV/full driving licence) apply – e.g., a 15 year old can compete in the senior baking class.

All entrants must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent.

Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine. County Federation offices are urged to ensure that when a member reaches Northern Area Field Day, their cards are valid and correct in the system. It is recommended membership cards are screenshot on phones or printed, failure to access the website is not a valid excuse for cards not being available.

ALL COMPETITORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE A SIGNED PARENTAL CONSENT FORM ON THEM AT ALL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE DAY AS WELL AS THEIR ONLINE MEMBERSHIP CARD.

Fines will be issued to Counties for any members/teams who drop out from a competition with less than 48 hours' notice (this includes not turning up on the day of the competition). £20 fine per individual competition, or £60 fine per team competition.

This is with the exception of fencing who must give a week's notice from competition to avoid a fine.

Anything less than a week will be fined £60.

If members cannot attend the Presentation of Awards, please ensure that someone is available to collect on your behalf.

2. REPRESENTATION

Counties may enter one competitor per 600 members of part thereof in the Northern Area Final.

Federations entering more than one team must designate them A, B or C. Once an entry has been made, competitors cannot be transferred from one team to another. The proportional representation will be calculated from the Membership Statistics as of 31 August 2025. **Members MUST know which team they are part of eg. A, B or C.**

NFYFC ruling on representing more than one County/Club in a calendar year or event, is as follows: That where a member represents a Club or County Federation in an Area event, they may not represent a different Club or County Federation in any other event in that same competition year (1st September to 31st August). However, a person who resigns from a Club and takes up membership of another, may represent that new Club or its County Federation as from the date of joining, except that they may not represent more than one Club or County Federation in successive rounds of the same competition which leads to a National Final".

3. AWARDS

All competitions on the day will count towards The Earl of Derby trophy.

Points will be awarded as follows: 1st place = 12 points, 2nd place = 11 points, 3rd place = 10 points, 4th place = 9 points and so on to 12th place = 1 point.

If a county does not enter a particular event, they will be awarded 0 points, however if they enter and are disqualified or fail to turn up, they will receive -1 point.

The team scoring the highest overall points will win The Earl of Derby trophy.

The team scoring the highest points in Stock judging will win The Barclays Bank trophy. Certificates will be awarded to teams placed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each event. Individual members of a team will receive a certificate.

4. TIMETABLE

Competitors may compete in more than one competition where the timetable allows them to do so. The timetable is final and will not be changed to accommodate any individual or team. Any competitor not reporting at the time stated, or being unable to compete when we require, will be eliminated, and therefore awarded (-1) point. The organisers will make every effort to keep competitions running to the times stated however cannot be responsible if due to unforeseen circumstances they are unable to do so.

5. JUDGES/STEWARDS DECISIONS

The judges' decision is final. Written notification of intention to lodge a complaint or to dispute the result must be received half an hour prior to the presentation of awards and should be accompanied by a £10 cash deposit. The £10 deposit shall be returned to the individual complaining if the complaint is sustained. If the complaint is not sustained the fee shall be forfeited. Please note that complaints will ONLY be accepted from a competing member or team captain.

Unacceptable behaviour by competitors or supporters, which adversely affects other competitors, will be penalised.

Abusive behaviour towards Judges and Stewards will, in continual and extreme cases, lead to disqualification.

Members are reminded that in taking part in the competitions, material of a questionable nature will be penalised.

Members are to bear in mind that they are within a family audience setting.

6. Northumberland YFC/Northern Area YFC reserves the right to amend or cancel any of the Rules.

7. Northumberland YFC/Northern Area YFC will not be responsible for any expenses incurred by competitors nor for arrangements for accommodation.

8. HEALTH & SAFETY & SAFEGUARDING

All competitions at Northern Area Field Day will be Risk Assessed to ensure the safety of competitors, supporters, and guests.

Competitors should be aware of relevant Health & Safety issues and thus always follow the instructions of judges and stewards.

Northumberland YFC will not accept responsibility for any members under the age of 18 who have not produced their Parental Consent Form on the day of the Northern Area Field Day. If the relevant forms are

not available at the Northern Area Field Day, then in accordance with the Federation's safeguarding, members will not be allowed to take part.

9. HELPING MEMBERS WITH ADDITIONAL NEEDS

Northumberland YFC supports NFYFC in their effort to seek the inclusion of the full membership in all its endeavours. Should a member require assistance to compete at Northern Area Field Day due to additional needs, every effort shall be made to ensure inclusion of the individual with dignity, respect, and confidentiality. Northumberland YFC requests prior knowledge of assistance required to maximise the benefit to the individual.

10. INSURANCE

The cover provided by the NFYFC Insurance Scheme will apply to all Clubs and members participating in Competitions. Each Club has been supplied with full details, and further information is readily available from the YFC Insurance Department, NFU Mutual Insurance Society Limited on 0191 212 5710.

CLASS 9. 4X4 AND TRAILER HANDLING

ELIGIBILITY

May enter one female and one male member.

Competitors to be between 18 and 28 years of age on the 1st September 2025.

All competitors must be a full member of a club affiliated to the NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or a printed equivalent.

Along with their full drivers licence.

NO DRIVERS LICENCE = NO COMPETING.

PROCEDURE

Team of 2. One female and one male. Competitors will be required to drive the vehicle and livestock trailer around a marked out course. One competitor driving around the course, then the other competitor reversing back along the same course.

Anyone seen to be driving in an unsafe manner will be stopped/disqualified by the competition judge or steward.

SCALE OF MARKS

To be judged on accuracy and safety NOT SPEED.

Lowest penalties collected wins.

Time penalties will be given for any hitting of stakes in the process.

5 points penalty for hitting stakes.

10 points penalty for driving over stakes.

Skill and safety of manoeuvres: 50

Accuracy overall: 50

TOTAL: 100

CLASS 10. MINI DIGGER HANDLING

ELIGIBILITY

May enter one member.

Competitors to be between the age of 16 and 28 years of age on 1 September 2025.

All competitors must be a full member of a club affiliated to the NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent.

Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

ALL COMPETITORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE A SIGNED PARENTAL CONSENT FORM ON THEM AT ALL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE DAY AS WELL AS THEIR ONLINE MEMBERSHIP CARD.

PROCEDURE

Competitors will be required to operate a mini digger as directed by the judge to complete a task.

Note: The mini digger will remain stationary and only the boom arm will be operated by the competitor for the task, as instructed by the judge.

TIMING

Competitors will be allowed 10 minutes maximum to complete the task, but competitors should remember that the competition will operate as a time trial.

CLASS 11. 12. 13. JUNIOR, INTERMEDIATE, SENIOR BREEDING SHEEP STOCKJUDGING

ELIGIBILITY

Junior - 16 years of age or under on the 1st September 2025

Intermediate - 21 years of age or under on the 1st September 2025.

Senior - 28 years of age or under on the 1st September 2025.

All competitors must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or printed equivalent.

Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

ALL COMPETITORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE A SIGNED PARENTAL CONSENT FORM ON THEM AT ALL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE DAY AS WELL AS THEIR ONLINE MEMBERSHIP CARD.

PROCEDURE

Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on 4 breeding sheep. Breed of sheep being judged TBC. Animals will be designated A, B, X, Y. All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which must be worn during the period of the competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area. Cards will be supplied to each competitor on which must be marked the order the competitor places the items. Only the tear-off section of the card may be used for making notes. During the competition, no other papers or literature may be used.

TIMING

Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes for inspection and handling of the items and each competitor will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score.

ALL COMPETITORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE A SIGNED PARENTAL CONSENT FORM ON THEM AT ALL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE DAY AS WELL AS THEIR ONLINE MEMBERSHIP CARD.

PROCEDURE

Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on 4 beef/store cattle. Animals will be designated A, B, X, Y. All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which must be worn during the period of the competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area. Cards will be supplied to each competitor on which must be marked the order the competitor places the items. Only the tear-off section of the card may be used for making notes. During the competition, no other papers or literature may be used.

TIMING

Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes for inspection and handling of the items and each competitor will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score.

Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area. Cards will be supplied to each competitor on which must be marked the order the competitor places the items. Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes for inspection and handling of the items and each competitor will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score.

May enter one female and one male competitor.

Competitors must be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2025.

All competitors must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or a printed equivalent.

Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

ALL COMPETITORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE A SIGNED PARENTAL CONSENT FORM ON THEM AT ALL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE DAY AS WELL AS THEIR ONLINE MEMBERSHIP CARD.

PROCEDURE

Each team will be supplied with 2 pallets which they are to dismantle and make into an item which will be revealed on the Northern Area Field day. The majority of wood should be used in the construction. No staining, no painting. No finish allowed. No power / battery tools, chainsaws or nail guns allowed.

Competitors must bring own tools. Nails provided.

Safety clothing must be worn – Steel toecap boots, gloves and goggles.

CLASS 24. OPEN - FLORAL ART

ELIGIBILITY

May enter one exhibit.

Competitors must be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2025.

All competitors must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or a printed equivalent.

Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

ALL COMPETITORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE A SIGNED PARENTAL CONSENT FORM ON THEM AT ALL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE DAY AS WELL AS THEIR ONLINE MEMBERSHIP CARD.

PROCEDURE

Competitors are to create a Floral Arrangement to the theme of “Wild West” – an arrangement to be viewed from the front only.

Arrangement MUST NOT exceed 60cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height. Display board behind arrangement is allowed, MUST be within the given measurements. Arrangement to be composed of natural plant material. Pre-cut and pre-soaked floral foam allowed. BIO-DEGRADABLE floral foam must be in a water container - New pieces of BIO-DEGRADABLE floral foam MUST be used on the day of the competition.

All the work of arranging and assembling the material must be carried out during the competition.

Competitors must wear white coats. No pre-cut flowers

Competitors will have a table for unpacking/setting up/working from. Then a separate display table will be available for all finish products to go on.

PLEASE NOTE THIS WILL BE ON THE DAY, COMMENCING AT 10AM.

TIMINGS

Competitors are allowed one hour to include final checks and measurement of the exhibit. Before leaving the competing area, competitors will be given a further 5 minutes to clear and tidy the work site.

Competitors may unpack their equipment and plant material/flowers onto the work table before the one hour practical session commences. Competitors are able to construct and tape their oasis in position prior to the one hour practical session if required. Competitors are able to set up their oasis and display boards before the one hour practical session commences.

All competitors must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.

Competitors will be required to produce their current online membership card or a printed equivalent.

Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

ALL COMPETITORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE A SIGNED PARENTAL CONSENT FORM ON THEM AT ALL TIMES THROUGHOUT THE DAY AS WELL AS THEIR ONLINE MEMBERSHIP CARD.

PROCEDURE

Competitors will be required to create an outfit suitable for a cowboy or cowgirl using up cycled materials. Pictures of the full process from beginning to end to be provided on a storyboard. Female competitors will be required to drink a half yard of alcoholic ale.

Male competitors will be required to drink a yard of alcoholic ale.
