 - SĎ last meeting was on Tuesday 18th July. Main thing on agenda, financial matters. Tom & Caisha to put together a clear split on financial responsibilities. Keen for Tom to coming to meetings to share and guide on the financial position of county. Give an idea of budgets. Want info for members to have in hand when it comes to AGM and membership fees. Zoom meeting following staff management progress. Looking at some form of words together to look at Vice Presidents etc. We felt that at the last meeting and AGM, not an exceptional situation. Members might not understand what it means, what the role is and what sort of person you want in that role. Should there be a term in office. Prompt a conversation about it.
